THE IMPORTANCE OF SUSTAINABLE TOURISM AT LEOPARD SANDS KRUGER PARK

Leopard Sands Kruger Park was founded with a deep commitment to conservation, community, and sustainability. Our story began on community-owned land that was once under threat from deforestation, as local families were forced to cut down trees for firewood to survive. Through timely intervention and a shared vision for the future, this land was rescued, preserving the last stands of indigenous forest and providing a safe haven for countless bird species that rely on wild fruits to sustain their populations.

Situated along the fence line of the Sabie River, Leopard Sands Kruger Park plays a vital role in protecting this precious ecosystem. Our location allows us to provide 24-hour security support to the Kruger National Park, helping to deter poaching and illegal fishing along this stretch of land. In close partnership with SANParks, we actively patrol the riverbanks daily, ensuring that wildlife and natural habitats remain protected for future generations.

At the heart of our operation lies the **Belfast Trust village**, home to the local community whose wellbeing and empowerment are integral to our mission. We are proud to employ, train, and uplift individuals from this community, offering meaningful career opportunities that allow families to thrive while becoming passionate custodians of the land. This mutual commitment has fostered awareness and pride in conservation efforts, helping to strengthen the protection of the park and its borders.

Our collaboration with the **SANParks Honorary Rangers** further extends our conservation impact. Through contributions of time, resources, and funding, we assist their tireless efforts in preserving the delicate balance of the Kruger ecosystem.

At Leopard Sands, we believe that true conservation means **enjoying nature while leaving it undisturbed**,



taking only photographs and leaving only footprints. The Kruger National Park spans over 2.2 million hectares and features a well-developed network of tar and gravel roads designed to minimize environmental impact. We strongly encourage all guests to remain on these designated roads during safaris.

Driving off-road, though tempting for a closer look at wildlife, causes long-term damage to the environment. Off-roading destroys grazing areas, termite mounds, owl burrows, and habitats of countless small creatures. Repeated vehicle tracks lead to soil erosion, invasive plant growth, and irreversible harm to the natural landscape. By respecting the established routes, we preserve both the integrity of the ecosystem and the authenticity of wildlife behavior, ensuring that each sighting remains a genuine encounter with nature at its most natural.

Sustainable tourism is not just a philosophy at Leopard Sands Kruger Park, it is the foundation of everything we do. Together with our guests, our community, and our conservation partners, we are working to protect this extraordinary wilderness so that generations to come can experience the magic of the Kruger in its purest form.

ELEPHANT INTERACTION

DEPOSIT POLICY:

20% deposit is required to confirm a booking. The balance is payable 28 days prior to arrival. For bookings made within 28 days of arrival, full payment is required at the time of booking.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

- More than 28 days before arrival: A full refund of the deposit.
- 15-28 days before arrival: 50% of the total booking amount will be charged.
- No show: 100% of the total booking amount will be charged.

GROUP BOOKINGS AND CANCELLATION POLICY:

Any booking of 10 pax or more rooms constitutes a group booking and will be subject to the below cancellation policy:

- 20% deposit is required to confirm the booking.
- 60 days prior to arrival: A further 30% is required.
- The balance is payable 42 days prior to arrival.
- If cancelled 150 - 90 days prior to arrival: 50% of the total booking amount will be charged.
- If cancelled 89 - 43 days prior to arrival: 50% of the total booking amount will be charged.
- If cancelled less than 42 days prior to arrival: 100% of the total booking amount will be charged.
